CPC® Training Course Syllabus

Prerequisites: Strong knowledge of medical terminology, anatomy, and physiology highly recommended.

Clock Hours: 80 (Please note: This is the time spent working within the course and does not include time spent studying. Individual study times will vary based on your learning style.)

Course Length: 16 weeks of live lectures and weekly study hours. It is recommended that students complete all coursework within the 16-week period, however you'll have access to the course for up to 12 months from the start date.

Certification of Completion: You will receive a certificate of completion worth 40 CEUs upon successful completion of the training course with a score of at least 70/100.

Course Description: The student will learn basics of medical coding related to the three main code manuals: CPT®, ICD-10-CM, and HCPCS Level II. This course is highly recommended for anyone wishing to take the AAPC CPC® exam.

Methods of Evaluation: The educational methods used include reading assignments, practical application assignments, quizzes, live lectures, chapter review exams, and a final exam. To receive a certificate of completion, students must successfully complete the course within the allotted time frame of 12 months or less (monthly extensions may be purchased). You must submit all graded assignments and score at least 70/100 on all assignments and overall grade. No reduced hours in the course or tuition discount for previous education or training will be granted (A+ Revenue Cycle Training recommends a bootcamp session if you have prior education or experience).
